Our Teachers

All teachers are experienced graduates and most having teaching qualifications as well. Most have been working at Fig Tree or several years. All are committed to continuous professional development as well as their Islamic development. We are fortunate to have a dedicated team that cares for the children and their welfare, constantly developing pupils potential.

The office for standards in education (OFSTED) a government body inspects the school regularly. Ofsted reports are available on their website. The school governors also monitor the standard of teaching.

Assessment and Reporting

Continuous assessment is used to monitor children's learning and this ensures progress at every stage. Teachers regularly mark homework, class work and end of unit tests. Parents receive feedback through two reports at the end of the autumn and summer terms. Parent's evening is held twice a year.
