Themed weeks:

Topic: Wonderful Weather (Hamilton History and geog objectives only from Block overview & add any IS LINK IN GREEN)



- Name weather types in the UK and identify seasonal changes within the year.

- Follow instructions to plant a seed and a bulb and understand that they need water, sun and suitable temperature to grow healthy.
- Explain plants are living things.
- Use observations to explain how we can tell plants are living things.

Art: Lowry (Hamilton History and geog objectives only from Block overview & add any IS LINK IN GREEN)



- Mix paint like Lowry.
- Paint a seascape.
- Draw simple buildings and simple matchstick figures.
- Compare two paintings.
- Assemble a collage in the style of Lowry.

PE: Netball

- Be able to throw a ball accurately to a partner while playing the sport.

- Be able to catch a ball when passed to them.
- To recognise simple passes that are played during the game.
